1 Mr. Majit S. Shaikh, learned counsel submits that he has instructions to appear on behalf of respondent No.1.

2 Heard the learned counsel for the applicant and the learned counsel for respondent No.1.

3 This is an application for condonation of delay of 62 days caused in filing the first appeal.

4 The learned counsel for respondent No.1 strongly opposed the application and submitted that there is no sufficient reason to condone the delay.

5 On perusal of the application, it appears that the delay has not

been deliberately caused. Therefore, in the interest of justice, the delay deserves to be condoned.

6 For the reasons stated in the application, the delay stands condoned. The application stands allowed in the interest of justice. The appeal be registered.

Appeal:

7 Issue notice to the respondents for final disposal, returnable on 15th December, 2025. Mr. Majit S. Shaikh, learned counsel waives notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

8 List the appeal for final disposal at admission stage on next date.

9 In addition to regular mode of service, private service, as is permissible in law, is permitted.

10 The record and proceedings be called for.
