PER COURT :

1. Heard the learned Counsel for the respective parties.
2. By way of this petition, the petitioner assails the order dated 05.04.2022 passed by the learned Additional Divisional Commissioner, Aurangabad in Sanchika No. 2021/ROR/REV/CR-04.
3. The petitioner is having an alternate and equally efficacious remedy against the order passed by the Additional Commissioner, Aurangabad, to file a revision before the State Government and this issue is already considered by the Hon'ble Apex Court **in the matter Gurudassing Nawoosing Panjwani Vs. State of Maharashtra and Others** reported in 2015 AIR SCW 6277 SUPREME COURT decided on 06.11.2015. In view thereof, the writ petition is disposed of, as not maintainable. No order as to costs.

4. The petitioner may file revision before the State Government within a period of eight weeks from today.
5. Delay in prosecuting the present writ petition be taken into consideration while, considering the application for condonation of delay.
6. If petitioner files Revision before the State Government within eight weeks, the State Government shall decide the same within a period of six months thereafter.
