2. Applicants are praying for condonation of delay of 3783 days and
3717 days in their respective appeals.

3. Applications are contested by the respondents. I have gone through the reply filed by the learned AGP. There is no material on record to infer any oblique motive on the part of the applicants to prefer the appeals belatedly. The applicants are ready to forgo the interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period. It is desirable to condone the delay.
