- . Heard both sides.
2. Applicants are praying for condonation of delay of 3779 days and 3703 days in their respective appeals.

3. Applications are contested by the respondents. The averments of the application are not denied. There is no material on record to infer any oblique motive on the part of the applicants to prefer the appeals belatedly. The applicants are ready to forgo the interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period. It is desirable to condone the delay.
