ORDER

(22nd March, 2025)

1. Learned counsel for both sides placed on record terms of compromise.
2. Terms of compromise taken on record and marked as "X" for identification.
3. Respondents/original claimants are present. They confirm that compromise is voluntary and same is duly signed/thumb impressed by claimants and their advocates. Learned counsel for respondents has identified the claimants.
