ORDER :

. Issue notice to the respondents. Learned AGP waives notice for respondent Nos.1 to 3. There is no necessity to issue notice to respondent No.4.

2. Learned AGP places on record a copy of letter dated 07.11.2025, which is taken on record by marking as Exhibit-‘X’. It has been stated that after the scrutiny of the proposal in respect of second benefit of petitioner’s Assured Career Progress Scheme, certain deficiencies have been found. Learned AGP makes a statement that if those deficiencies would be removed, then the said proposal would be considered.

3. Taking into consideration this aspect, respondent No.4 is directed to comply with the letter dated 07.11.2025 within a period of 15 days from today and after the receipt of such response from respondent No.4, respondent No.3 to consider the said proposal within a period of one month thereafter.

4. With these directions, the writ petition stands disposed of.
