1. Heard the learned Counsel for the respective parties.
2. By way of present petition, the petitioner assails the order dated 18.05.2023 passed by the Collector Nanded, in file No. 2022/GB/Desk-1/Gra pa ni/CR-25 whereby the complaint filed by the petitioner for disqualification of respondent No. 3 came to be dismissed.
3. The petitioner had filed complaint on the ground that respondent No. 3 had failed to hold the Gram Sabha which is mandatory as per Section 7 and 36 of the Maharashtra Village Panchayats Act, 1959.
4. Both the learned Counsel submit that the election was held in the year 2021 and hardly one month's term remains, therefore, without going into the controversy. the present petition is disposed of.
