ORDER

1. Heard rival submissions.
2. The applicants in all these applications, are seeking
condonation of delay of 45 days which appears to be caused due to

their poor financial condition.

3. The learned AGP as well as learned counsel for Acquiring Body, strongly opposed the applications on the ground that no reasonable cause is mentioned for condoning the delay.
