1. Heard both the sides.
2. Applicant seeks to condone delay of 937 days in preferring first appeal.
3. Respondent No.3/acquiring body has not contested the application. The averments of the application have gone uncontroverted. There is no oblique motive in preferring appeal belatedly. The delay stands condoned on condition that applicant shall not be entitled to interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period.
