PER COURT :

The applicant is praying for direction to the Acquiring Body to deposit balance 50% of the amount. It is submitted by the learned advocate for the respondent-acquiring body that in pursuance of the earlier order, 50% of the amount along with interest was deposited and that was even disbursed to the applicant.

2. Considering overall circumstances, I find that it is desirable to direct the respondent-Acquiring Body to deposit balance amount in this Court.

3. The Civil Application is partly allowed by directing the respondent-Acquiring Body to deposit balance amount with accrued interest in this Court within a period of 12 weeks.
