1. This is an Application for condonation of 2681 days delay caused in preferring the First Appeal for enhancement of compensation awarded by the learned Reference Court i.e. 6<sup>th</sup> Jt. Civil Judge (S. D.), Aurangabad *vide* Judgment and Award dated 21/03/2013 in Land Acquisition Reference No.333/2001.

2. The Respondents are duly served. The learned A.G.P. appears for Respondent Nos.1 and 2. None appears for Respondent No.3.
