PER COURT :

1. Learned counsel for Respondent No. 1 raised objection with regard to maintainability of the Petition as revision is provided under Section 154 of Maharashtra Cooperative Societies Act.

2. Learned counsel for Petitioners, on instructions, seeks withdrawal of the petition with liberty to file revision before the revisional authority.

3. Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file revision. If revision is filed within a period of four weeks, objection to the limitation shall not be raised or entertained.

4. Interim relief granted earlier to continue for a period of four weeks. Revisional authority not to continue this order thereafter. However, it is open for the Petitioners to convince the revisional authority on merit for seeking any relief.
