**PER COURT :-**

1. Applicant seeks to condone delay of 197 days in preferring cross-objection.
2. The averments of the application have not been controverted. First appeal preferred by acquiring body is admitted by condoning delay. The delay stands condoned on condition that if the applicant succeeds in the cross objection, he shall not be entitled to the interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period.
3. Civil application for delay is allowed.

**Cross-Objection**

4. Issue notice to the respondents.
5. Learned AGP waives service of notice for respondent/s-State. Learned counsel Mr. Gude waives service of notice for respondent No.3.
6. It shall be heard along with first appeal.

**Civil Application for Stay**

7. As the amount is deposited in pursuance of the orders of this Court, ad-interim relief granted earlier shall stand confirmed.
8. Civil application is disposed of.
