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**PER COURT :**

1. The Petitioner is before the court praying for a direction to the concerned police station to register an FIR. Her husband is said to have passed away due to the negligence of the two doctors.

2. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submits that the Petitioner has a remedy of approaching the competent court invoking Section 175(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (earlier Section 156(3) of the Cr.P.C.).

3. The learned advocate for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner would avail of the said remedy and the disposal of this

Petition should not be treated as an impediment.
