These applications are for withdrawal of amount deposited by the respondent-Acquiring Body.

2. It is pointed out that in similarly circumstanced appeals such a request for withdrawal of amount has been granted permitting the claimants to receive 50% of the amount along with accrued interest on furnishing undertaking and 25% of the amount along with accrued interest on furnishing solvent surety/security. I propose to follow the order dated 06.10.2025 passed by the coordinate bench in group of appeals.

3. The Civil Applications are partly allowed.

4. The applicants are permitted to withdraw 50% of the amount with accrued interest on furnishing undertaking and 25% of the amount with accrued interest on furnishing solvent surety/security to the satisfaction of Registrar Judicial of this Court. Balance amount shall be invested in any nationalized bank.
