2. The applicant seeks to condone the delay of 5891 days in preferring appeal seeking enhancement of the compensation. The learned counsel for the applicant seeks condonation of delay for the reasons stated in the application.

3. The application is contested by the learned A.G.P, who is appearing for respondent nos. 1 and 2. None appears for the contesting respondent no. 3.

4. The averments of the application have not been traversed. There is no material on record to infer any *mala fides* on the part of the applicant. This Court has no alternative than to accept the reasons stated in the application for condonation of delay. The applicants are ready to forgo interest and the statutory benefits for the delayed period.

5. The delay stands condoned subject to forfeiture of interest and

statutory benefits for the delayed period.
