PER COURT :-

1. The applicants seek condonation of delay of 564 days in preferring the Civil Revision Application.
2. Mr. Bhumkar, learned counsel appears for respondent no.1A to 1C. Mr. Bhavthankar, learned counsel appears for respondent nos.2 who is a formal party. The respondents vehemently oppose the application.
3. The averments in the application have not been controverted by the respondents. There is nothing on record to infer that the revision is filed belatedly with oblique motive.
