PER COURT :-

1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned AGP for respondents/State. None for the contesting acquiring body.
2. This application is for condonation of delay of 1691 days in preferring appeal. As there is no contest to the application by contesting party, I do not find that there is an impediment in condoning the delay.
3. Learned AGP has opposed the application for condonation of delay.
4. I find no malafides on the part of the applicant to approach this Court belatedly. It is conceded by learned

counsel that applicant is ready to forego the interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period.

5. Civil application is allowed and the delay caused in appeal shall stand condoned on condition that applicant shall not be entitled to interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period.

7. Learned AGP waives service of notice for the respondents/State.

8. Call for Record and Proceedings from the concerned Court.

9. It is clarified that applicant shall not be entitled to interest and the statutory benefits for the delayed period.
