1. Not on board. Taken on board.
2. While disposing Writ Petition No.15752 of 2023, this Court directed to deposit cost of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh) in this Court which was made payable to respondent nos.1 and 2.

Present civil application is filed on behalf of original respondent no.1 contending that name of applicant/respondent no.1 is mentioned as Sumanbai Motiram Pail as legal heir of Shankar Tanu Bhusare in the proceeding of Writ Petition No.15752 of 2023 as well as other litigation. The applicant has remarried with one Yadavrao Patil and, therefore, she is now referred as Sumanbai Yadavrao Patil.
