PER COURT :-

1. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable on 15.12.2025.
2. Learned AGP waives service of notice for respondents-State.
3. Applicant seeks condonation of delay of 1727 days. Besides the grounds stated in the application, it is mentioned that the matter is likely to be settled in Lok-Adalat. Considering the length of delay, I am of the considered view that applicant shall not be entitled to the interest and the statutory benefits for the delayed period.

4. Civil application is allowed by condoning delay on condition that applicant shall not be entitled to the statutory benefits and the interest for the delayed period as well as for the lapses.

6. Learned AGP waives service of notice for respondents-State.

7. Call for Record and Proceedings from the concerned Court.

8. Print is dispensed with.

9. The applicant shall not be entitled to the statutory benefits and the interest for the delayed period as well as for the lapses.
