**Applications for condonation of delay:**

2 These applications are for condonation of delay of 707 days  
caused in filing the first appeals.

3 The learned AGP strongly opposed the applications and submitted that there is no sufficient reason to condone the delay.

4 On perusal of the applications, it appears that the delay has not been deliberately caused. Therefore, in the interest of justice, the delay deserves to be condoned on certain conditions.

5 For the reasons stated in the applications, the delay stands condoned. The applications stand allowed in the interest of justice. The appeals be registered.

6 It is made clear that in case the amount of compensation is enhanced, the appellants shall not be entitled for the amount of interest for the delayed period.
