1. Heard Mr. Azizoddin R. Syed, learned Counsel for the Petitioners, Mr.M.M. Bhokarikar, learned Counsel for respondent No. 1-2, Mr. V.S.Badakh, learned AGP for Respondent No.2-State and Mr. Tambe Rahul A. learned Counsel for Respondent No.3
2. The petitioners challenge the order dated 17.07.2023 passed below Exh. 74 and order dated 04.08.2023 passed below Exh. 105 by the learned Civil Judge Senior Division, Bhusawal.
3. Learned AGP for respondent-State points out contentions stated in paragraph No. 8 and 9 of the affidavit-in-reply and submits that the proceeding is already disposed of and therefore, nothing survives in the Writ Petition.
4. However, the learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that though specific contentions are raised in paragraph Nos. 8 and 9 of the affidavit in reply but till this date the orders are not made available

despite of the efforts taken by the petitioners.
