ORDER :

1. In view of our order dated 11th September 2025, the girl has been produced before this Court. Respondent Nos.2 and 3 have appeared. The petitioner and respondent Nos.2 and 3 have entered into the compromise and it is placed on record. Respondent No.2 had expressed readiness to take the petitioner for cohabitation.
