PER COURT :

1. Present application is for condonation of delay of 670 days caused in filing appeal against judgment and award passed by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal at Jalna in M.A.C.P. No.183 of 2014
2. Learned Advocate for applicant submits, there is no deliberate and intentional delay and therefore, in the interest of justice and fair opportunity, delay so caused is sought to be condoned.

3. Learned Advocate for the respondents raised formal objection to condone the delay.

4. For the reasons mentioned in civil application, more particularly in paragraph no.2 and in the interest of justice and fair opportunity, delay caused is required to be condoned. Delay stands condoned. Civil application stands disposed off. Appeal be duly registered.
