APPLICATION FOR STAY

1. This is an application seeking stay to the execution of the impugned judgment and award.
2. The learned advocate for the applicant / appellant submits that the entire amount as per the impugned judgment and award is deposited in this Court.

::ORDER::

APPLICATION FOR DELAY

1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
