PER COURT :

1. Heard the respective counsels.
2. Learned counsel Mr. Patil has instructions to appear for respondent nos. 1 and 2. Mr.Patil waives service of notice for respondent nos. 1 and 2.
3. There was a delay of 60 days in preferring restitution of the writ petition dismissed for non-compliance.
4. Learned counsel for the contesting respondent nos. 1 and 2 strongly opposed the application.
