PER COURT :

1. By filing affidavit-in-reply, learned advocate for respondents No. 2 to 4 have contended that the order is complied with. Learned advocate for petitioner, however, disputes the payments made to him, stating that 50% of the salary is paid to him. When he was entitled for basic salary of Rs.25,780/-, the same is reduced to Rs.16,250/-.

2. Learned advocate for respondents No. 2 to 4 submits that as total 16 teachers including present petitioner failed to get ME degree or failed to pass NET/SET examination, their salary was reduced as per the University norms.

3. In view of compliance of the order, the contempt petition is disposed of. If the petitioner is aggrieved by the deduction of salary, he may avail appropriate remedy as per law.
