PER COURT :

1. This is an application for condonation of delay of 289 days in filing the application for leave to appeal by private party.
2. Learned Advocate for applicant pointed out that, reasons for delay are spelt out in paragraph nos.2 to 5 of the application and stated that there is no deliberate and intentional delay. That, there is a good case in appeal and therefore, in the interest of justice and fair opportunity, delay so caused is sought to be condoned.

3. Learned Advocate for the respondent No.1 strongly opposed the application, contending that there is no plausible explanation for the delay.

4. After going through the application and for the reasons stated in paragraph Nos.2 to 5 of the application and in the interest of justice and fair opportunity, delay so caused requires to be condoned. The application stands allowed and disposed of. Delay stands condoned.

5. Registry to verify and to take further steps.

6. Issue notice to the respondents in application for leave to appeal by private party, returnable on 20.11.2025. Learned Advocate Mr. A. I. Deshmukh waives notice on behalf of respondent No.1. Learned AGP waives notice on behalf of respondent no.2.
