CIVIL APPLICATION NO. 13496 OF 2025

1. This is an application for withdrawal of the amount deposited by the respondent/M.S.R.T.C. in this Court.

4. Considering the reasons stated in the application, Civil Application deserves to be allowed partly. Hence, the following order:

ORDER
