1. This is an Application for condonation of 614 days delay caused in preferring the First Appeal against the Judgment and Award dated 14/12/2017, passed by the learned Reference Court, in Land Acquisition Reference No.465/2008.
2. Heard the learned Advocate for the Applicants, learned A.G.P for Respondent Nos.1 and 2 and the learned Advocate Mr. Khaire for Respondent No.3.
3. Learned A.G.P. for Respondent Nos.1 and 2 as well as learned Advocate for Respondent No.3 opposed the Application on the ground that, no reasonable grounds are mentioned in the Application. Hence, the aforesaid delay may not be condoned.
