PER COURT :-

1. Heard learned counsel Mr. Bilolikar for applicant and learned AGP for respondents/State. None appears for respondent No.3.
2. Applicant is seeking condonation of delay of 506 days in preferring first appeal. He is relying on paragraph Nos.2 to 4 of the application. The grounds pressed into service by the applicant are not controverted. The applicant is ready to forego interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period.
3. Civil application for delay is allowed in terms of prayer clause "B" on condition that the interest and the statutory benefits for the delayed period shall stand forfeited.

In First Appeal

4. **Admit.**

5. Learned AGP waives service of notice for respondents/State.

6. Call for Record and Proceedings from the concerned Court.

7. It is clarified that appellant shall not be entitled to the interest and statutory benefits for the delayed period.
