After hearing learned counsel for both sides for substantial time and when this Court has shown prima facie **inclination** to cause interference in the order, learned counsel for the contesting respondent, on instructions, makes statement that contesting respondent/original counter plaintiff desires to withdraw application Exhibit 171 in Special Civil Suit No. 15/2018 with liberty to file application for amendment to the counter plaintiff.

2. In view of above statement, order impugned stands set aside. Special Civil Suit No. 15/2018 stands restored. Counter plaintiff is permitted to file application for amendment counter plaintiff.
