1. Heard.
2. These are the applications for condonation of 1287, 3912, 5401, 1284, 1289, 3074, 161 and 124 days delay respectively caused in filing the Civil Applications for bringing the legal representatives of deceased claimants on record as well as for setting aside abatement.
3. Learned advocate for the respondents strongly opposed the applications and submitted that sufficient reasons are not given in the applications to condone the delay and lastly prayed to reject the applications.

4. Perused the applications. Considering the reasons stated therein, it appears that the delay is not deliberately caused. Hence, the applications deserve to be allowed in the interest of justice. Hence, the following order:

::ORDER::

1. The applications are allowed by setting aside the abatement.
 2. The delay of 1287, 3912, 5401, 1284, 1289, 3074, 161 and 124 days respectively caused in filing the Civil Applications for bringing the legal representatives of deceased claimants on record is condoned.
 3. The applicants are directed to amend the appeal memo by bringing the legal representatives of the claimants on record within a week.
 4. The Civil Applications are disposed of.
5. List the matters on 22.12.2025 for final hearing.
