1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.
2. Issue notice to the respondents. Learned counsel Mr. Alok Sharma waives service of notice for respondent nos.1 to 4.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the issue involved in the case has been dealt with by this Court, was based upon Hexaware Technologies Limited Vs. Assistant Commissioner of Income Tax and 4 Ors, (2020) 464 ITR 430.
4. Learned counsel for the contesting respondents submits that Hexaware Technologies Limited is subjudiced before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and in another case, Advocate Mr. Alok Sharma for the contesting respondents states that the High Court of Madras has taken a different view. Therefore, the petition does not deserve any interim protection.

5. Based upon the same facts and issue involved in the matter, we have protected the petitioners. Hence, we follow the same course and pass the identical order.
