. Learned advocate for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner would not press for prayer clause (A) and would approach the administrative tribunal.

2. Considering the fact that the petitioner has already been terminated for failure to produce a certificate of caste validity, the writ petition is disposed of directing respondent No.2 scrutiny committee to decide his proposal as expeditiously as possible and in any case within three months.

3. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to resort to the appropriate remedy to challenge the order of termination.
