In view of the above, during the pendency of this petition, the service of the petitioner shall not be terminated only on the basis of the impugned order passed by the respondent No.2 – Scrutiny Committee, subject to the petitioner filing an undertaking within two weeks from today before this Court that during the pendency of this petition, he shall not claim any service benefit such as confirmation, promotion, increment, pay fixation etc. Copy of such undertaking shall also be placed before the office of respondent No.3, within the said period of two weeks.
