PER COURT :-

1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant. None appears for the respondents though duly served.
2. Present application is for condonation of delay of 64 days in preferring appeal challenging judgment and award dated 12.09.2024 passed in MACP No.62 of 2023.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that for the reasons stated in paragraph Nos.2 to 4, delay caused in preferring appeal needs to be condoned. There are no malafides on the part of the applicant. He would further submits that today he is armed with cheque of the amount

which was directed to be deposited while granting him ad-interim relief by order dated 02.04.2025.
