**ORDER :-**

Being aggrieved by the judgment and award passed by learned Member, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Beed, in MACP No.61/2021, the appellant, has preferred present First Appeal.

2. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable after four weeks. Call Record and proceedings.
3. The matter be listed after service of notice is complete. In the meantime, applicant/appellant shall take recourse to Chapter II of the Bombay High Court Appellate Side Rules, 1960, corresponding to the position of the matter.
4. Office objections be removed within two weeks, failing which the matter shall stand dismissed automatically without reference to the court.

**C.As. for Stay :-**

5. Being aggrieved by the judgment and award passed by learned Member, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Beed, in MACP No.61/2021, the appellant, has preferred present First Appeal. This application is for grant of stay.

6. The applicant submit that there is strong hope of success in the appeal. That, during pendency of the First Appeal, if execution and operation of the impugned judgment and award is not stayed, the very purpose of the appeal shall stand frustrated.

7. Considering this, execution and operation of the impugned judgment and award is stayed till returnable date, on condition that the appellant deposits the entire payable decretal award amount in this court before the returnable date.

8. Issue notice to the respondents.

9. The matter be listed after service of notice is complete. In the meantime, applicant/appellant shall take recourse to Chapter II of the Bombay High Court Appellate Side Rules, 1960, corresponding to the position of the matter.
