2. None for the respondent in spite of service.
3. This application is moved by the husband who is respondent in the original proceeding pending in the court of learned Judge, Family Court, Nashik. He seeks transfer of the proceeding to the learned JMFC, Nandurbar.

4. It is the case of the applicant that presently wife is also residing at Nandurbar and she has also filed one more proceeding at Nandurbar under the Domestic Violence Act in the court at Nandurbar. She has given address of Nandurbar in the said proceeding.
