1. Heard Mr. Chaudhari, learned counsel for the appellant, Mr. Lomte, learned APP for the respondent/State and Mr. Kande, learned counsel for respondent No.2.

2. Mr. Chaudhari, learned counsel for the appellant states that this appeal is arising out of Crime No.240/2025 which is registered with Bhokardan Police Station for the offence punishable under Sections 115(2), 281, 351(2), 351(3), 352 of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.
