On 12.04.2022, a statement was made on behalf of the Counsel for the Ponda Municipal Council that the demolition order dated 18.02.2019 will be executed.

2. It was recorded in the order dated 12.04.2022 that the demolition order has already attained finality, as there was no stay to the execution of the order. It was informed to the Court that the demolition drive shall be carried out and the compliance report shall be filed.
