On perusal of the pleadings in the Petition seeking a direction for quashing and setting aside the decision of the Respondent-authorities to stack the street vendors from the property bearing survey no. 121 of Chicalim, which, according to the Petitioner, has created nuisance for himself as well as the residents of the locality and since we find that the Petition is lacking in the necessary particulars to entertain the case of the Petitioner of nuisance,
