Since Mr Nadkarni, the learned Counsel representing Respondent No.6 has invited our attention to the foundation of the Petition filed by the components of Comunidade of Serula, as it is pleaded that the Managing Committee of Comunidade did not seem to be serious in pursuing the matter in respect of the structure standing in the property occupied by respondent no.6 and therefore the Petition is filed.

He submit that the Comunidade had already instituted a suit

against the Respondent No.6 bearing RCS No.103/2022 in which, the plaint is informed to be rejected on 10.05.2024, against which an appeal is preferred by the complainant which is presently pending.
