1. Registry to waive office objections and register the matter.
2. This is an application for condonation of 72 days of delay in filing the present revision application. The main cause of delay, as cited in the application, is that on advice, the Public Prosecutor before the Trial Court sought review of the impugned order which was rejected after which the concerned filed moved according to administrative requirements for sanction from the Director of Prosecution and other Departments.
