1. This is an application for regular bail.
2. The learned APP for the respondent/State submits that the trial has commenced and the prosecution has already examined four witnesses. It is thus submitted that present application, at this stage, may not be entertained.
3. On the other hand, learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is in jail for 3 years. The incident was not per-meditated and therefore, the applicant may be released on bail.
4. Considering the fact that the trial has commenced, at this stage, I am not inclined to entertain the present application. Hence, the Application is rejected. However, liberty is granted to the applicant to file fresh bail application, if the trial is not concluded within a period of six months.
