1. Present writ petition takes exception to order dated 30th January 2025, passed by learned Civil Judge, Senior Division, Sangli below Exhibit 10 in Regular Civil Suit No.435 of 2024, thereby rejecting the application of petitioners / plaintiffs seeking appointment of Court Commissioner.

2. The writ petition was posted on board for admission on 28th April 2025. However, none appeared for petitioners. Accordingly, it was adjourned to 16th June 2025, with a clarification that pendency of writ petition shall not be impediment for proceeding
