1. Heard Mr. Advait Shukla learned Advocate for the Applicant and Mr. T. G. Khan, learned APP for the State.
2. By the present application filed under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, Applicant is seeking bail in connection with C. R. No.137 of 2024 registered with Faujdar Chawadi Police Station, for the offences punishable under Section 395 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 along with Section 4 read with Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Section 135 of Maharashtra Police Act, 1951.
3. Mr. Advait Shukla learned Advocate for the Applicant, on instructions from the Applicant submits that in the event the

prosecution makes their stand clear on the number of witnesses to be examined, the Applicant would not press the present bail application.
