This interim application is filed by the first informant, seeking intervention in the anticipatory bail application.

2. In view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Jagjeet Singh & Ors. vs. Ashish Mishra @Monu & Anr., in Criminal Appeal No. 632 of 2022*, it is held that a victim is entitled to be heard

during adjudication of bail application of the accused.

3. In view of the same, the interim application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (a).

4. Amendment to be carried out forthwith. It is made clear that if the amendment is not carried out, the anticipatory bail application will stand dismissed without further reference to this Court.
