1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned APP for the Respondents.
2. The period of furlough has expired on 21 May 2025 and the accused has surrendered on that date. Meanwhile Mr. Kiran, son of the Petitioner met with an accident in the last week of April 2025 and had to undergo surgery and is in the hospital.
3. The learned APP produces letter from Kopergaon Police Station dated 18 May 2025 and the certificate issued by Dr. Vithalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation's Medical College and Hospital dated 9 May 2025. After perusing the report of the Police Station and the Medical Hospital. We are satisfied that the period of furlough be extended by 30 days as prayed for in prayer clause (B) of the petition.

4. The Accused will surrender on 22 June 2025 before the concerned Police Station. The authorities are now directed to release him from the custody.
5. The Petition is disposed of in above terms. No costs.
