The challenge in this petition is to an order dated 8th April, 2025, passed by the learned Joint Charity Commissioner, Kolhapur, on an application (Exhibit-20) filed by the petitioner in Revision Application No.20 of 2023 thereby rejecting the objection raised by the petitioner to the maintainability of the revision application against an order of de-registration of the trust.
3. Under Section 70A of the Maharashtra Public Trust Act, 1950, the Charity Commissioner can exercise power of revision, *sou moto*. The questions as to whether the revision is maintainable against the order impugned before the learned
